Recalling World War II

Angela Neal was a young girl growing up in England during World War II. She will speak of her experiences at The Episcopal Church of St. John the Baptist, Milton, on Wednesday, Oct. 11, at 7 p.m. The public is warmly invited to this free event. Fittingly, tea and biscuits--or what some might call cookies--will be served.

"Throughout those years I slept under the stairwell," Ms. Neal recalls. "It was the strongest area in the house, thus somewhat protective against nighttime bombing raids." She will address various other aspects of the war years, including blackouts, air-raid shelters, rationing and more. Afterward she will entertain questions.

Ms. Neal, a parishioner of St. John the Baptist, was very keen to accept the invitation to speak about her girlhood in wartime England, and immediately began preparing for the occasion.
