“Sandwich Thursdays”

The Episcopal Church of St. John the Baptist, Milton, will provide free sack lunches for hungry kids on Thursdays from June 22 through Aug. 31, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., at the parish’s vacant lot across Wharton Street from the parish’s parking lot. The sack lunch will include a lunch-meat sandwich, a piece of fruit, a sweet and a bottle of water, and will be available “to go” or may be enjoyed there at a table under a tent.

“Sandwich Thursdays” is the work of the parish’s very active Outreach Committee, and was conceived by committee member Clara Escobar. “Many children rely on school lunches, which are not available to them in the summer,” Ms. Escobar explained. “Our parish wants to step up and help fill that need—and those hungry stomachs.”

Tents, tables and a large banner will be erected at the grassy lot located just behind Gustafson’s Clock and Watch Repair. Inclement weather will relocate the event to the parish hall. Directions and contact information are at www.saintjohnsmilton.org.
