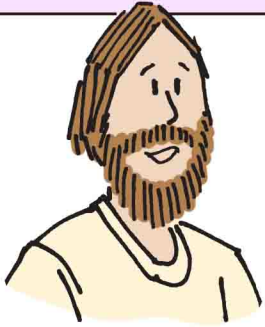


Who is the One Who

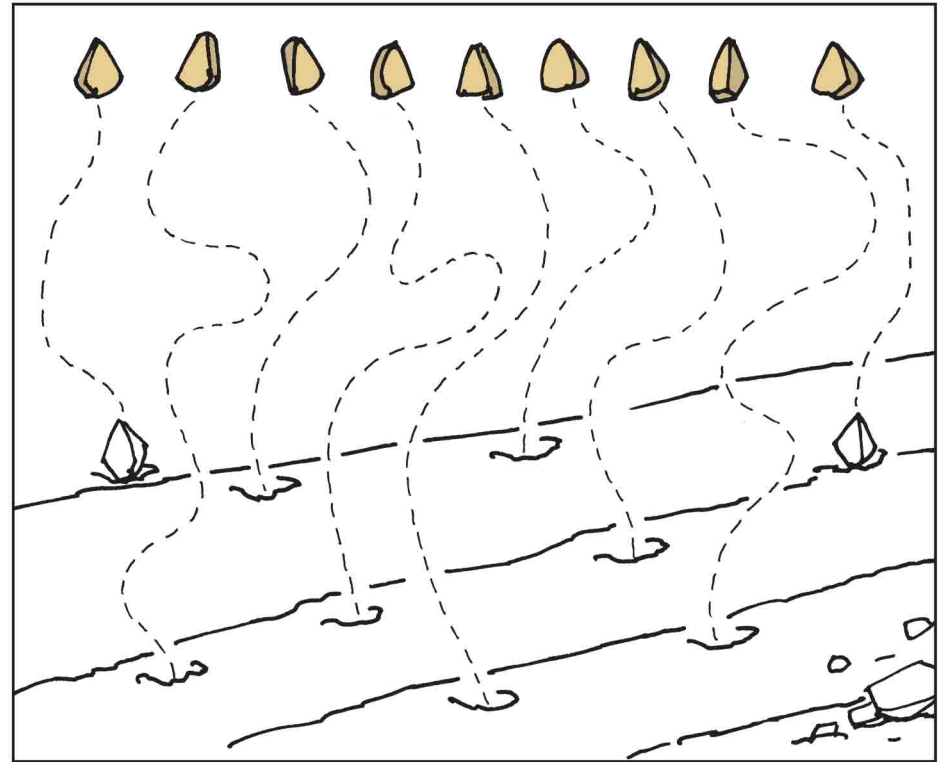

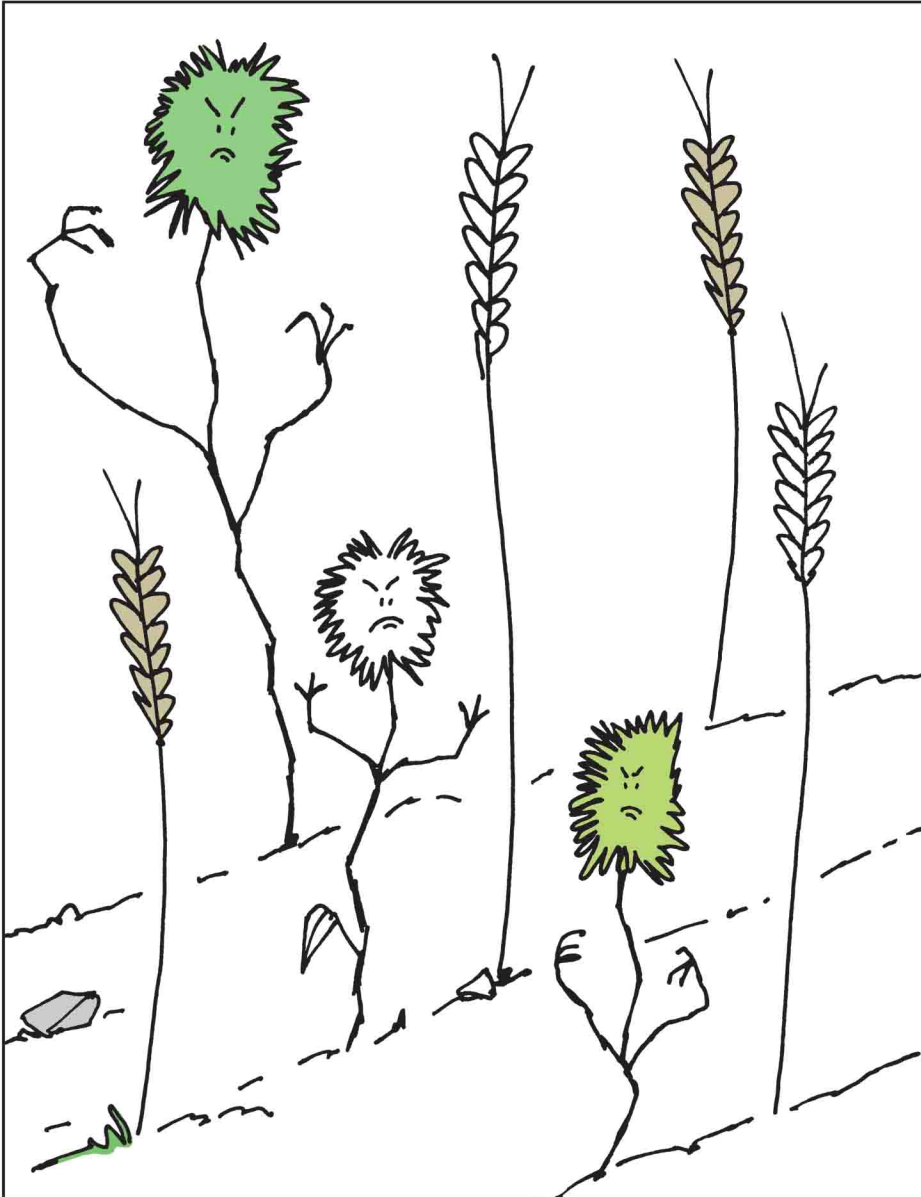
